The template project wizard is provided, which includes basic codes for the convenience of developer in developing eGovFrame applications.

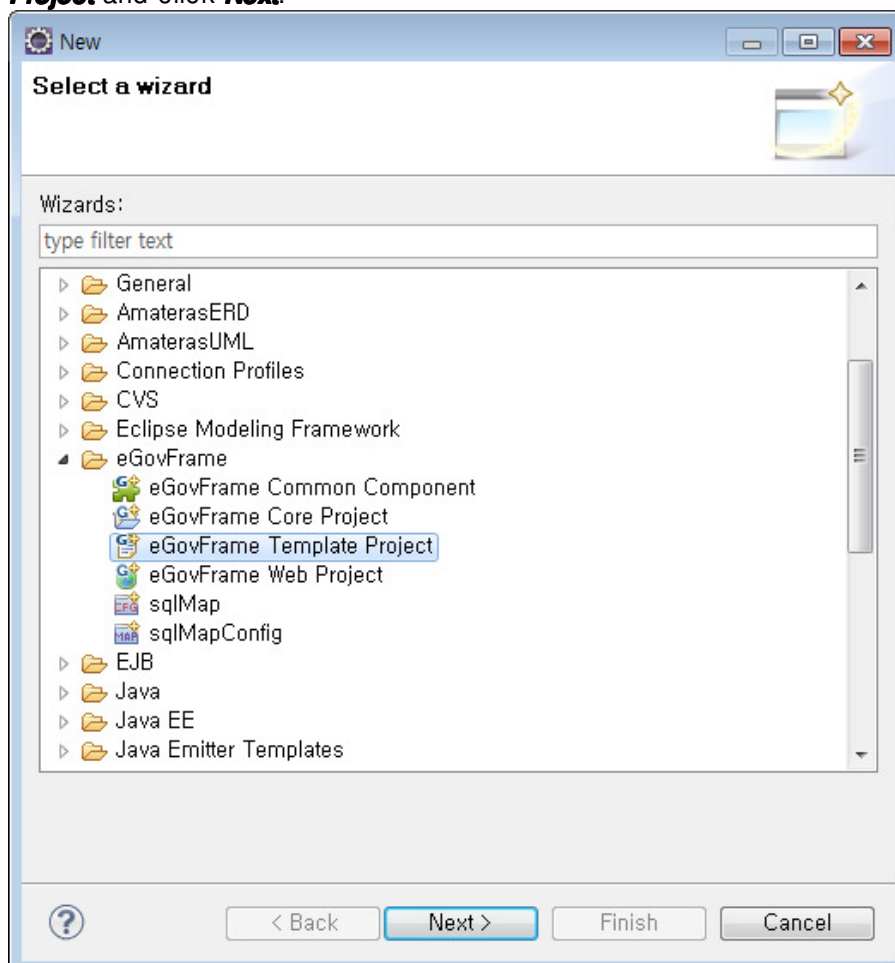
Description

The template project wizard includes eGovFrame based e- government standard framework common components.

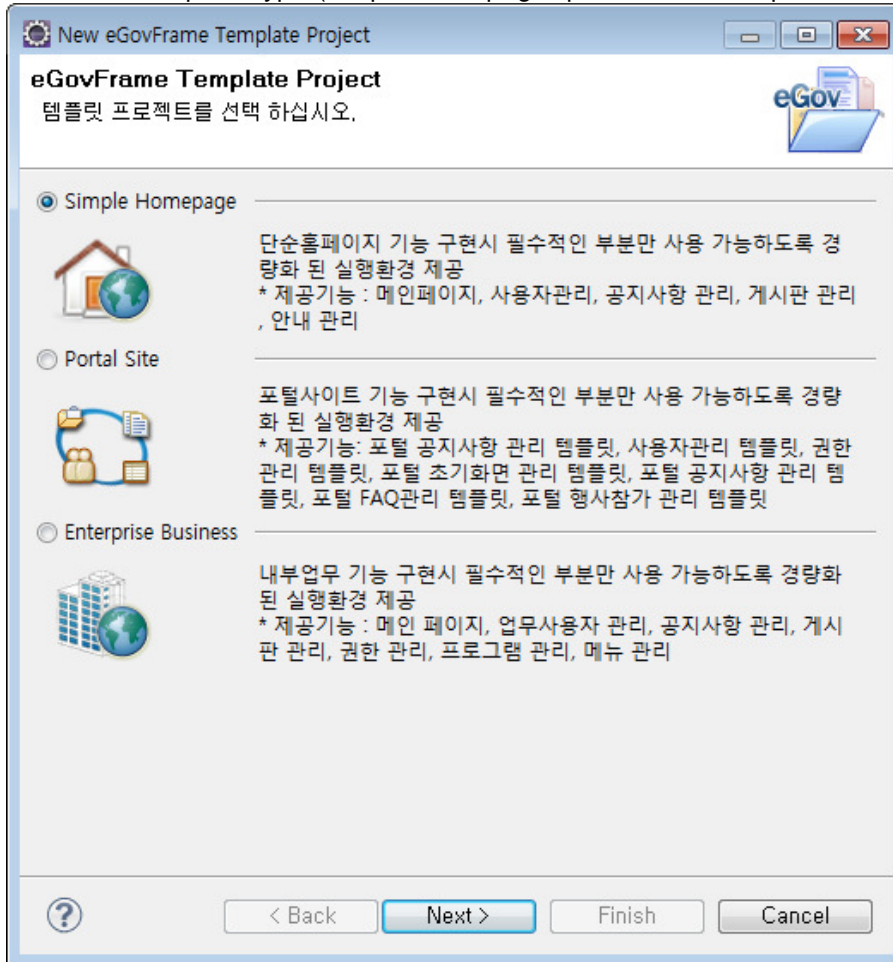
- Simple Homepage: a lightweight execution environment for a simple home page
 - Provides main pages, user management, announcements management, notice board management and guide management.
- Portal Site: provide a lightweight execution environment for portal site
 - Provides portal notice management template, user management template, permission management template, portal home screen management template, portal notice management template, portal FAQ management template, and portal event participation management template.
- Enterprise Business: a lightweight execution environment for enterprise business
 - Provides main page, user management, announcements management, notice board management, permission management, program management and menu management.

Manual

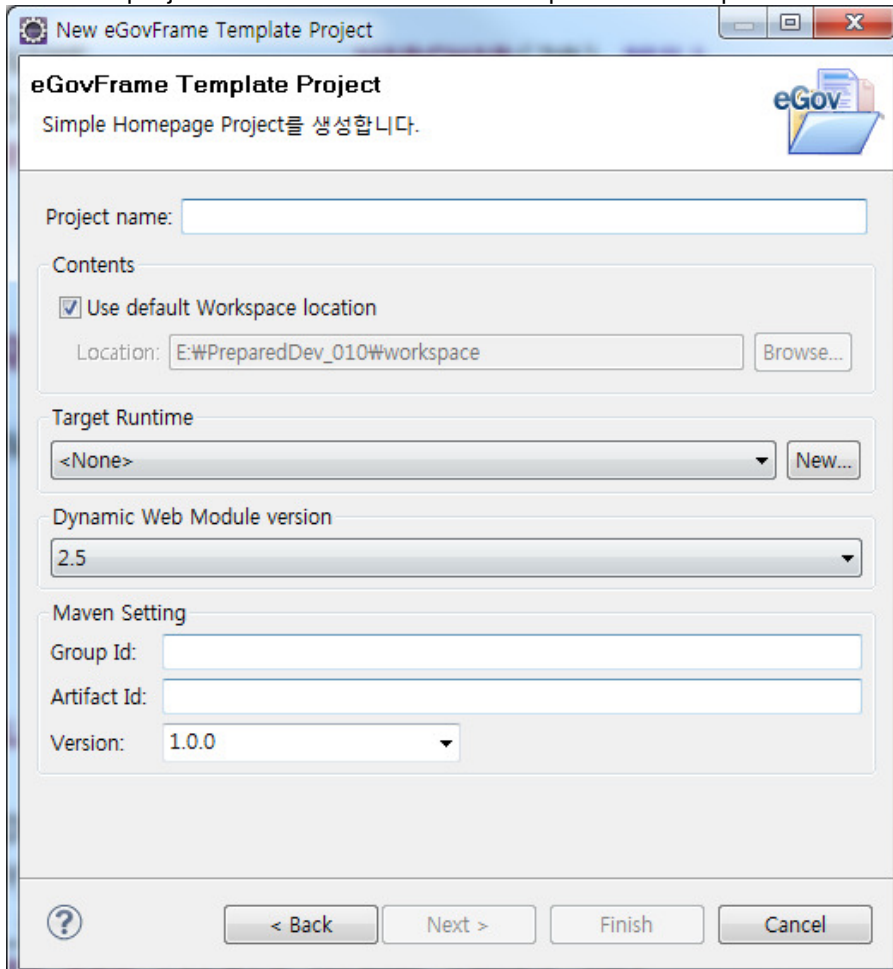
1. In the menu bar, select **File > New > eGovFrame Template Project**. (within eGovFrame Perspective) Or use **Ctrl+N** shortcut key to run the generation wizard. Select **eGovFrame > eGovFrame Template Project** and click **Next**.



2. Select the template type (simple homepage, portal site, enterprise business) to create and click **Next**.



3. Enter the project name and other values required to set up Maven and click **Finish**.



4. Run the server to check the created template project.

Option	Description	Default value
Project Name	Enter the new project name.	Space
Use default Workspace location	If you check the check box for Use default Workspace location, a project directory under the project name is created. If you want to select another directory and uncheck the option and click Browse button and select the location	Checked
Target Runtime	Select a target server that will run web applications.	<None>
Dynamic Web Module Version	Select the dynamic web module version	2.5
Group Id	Enter Group Id of Maven.	Space
Artifact Id	Enter Artifact Id of Maven.	Space
Version	Enter the version of Maven.	1.0.0

Notes

- ✓ When executing the project, set the target runtime to web/was server (ex:tomcat) currently used in Eclipse.
- ✓ After creation of project, if any error related with the import of javax.servlet.jsp.* in EgovComCrossSiteHndlr.java, refer to [jsp- api.jar import guide](#).
- ✓ The template project works normally only when database has been established. The e- government provides the script to build the database.

- After installation of template project, build the database schema and data as in the following.
 1. Install the template project.
 2. Run the script in DATABASE folder under the template project. The script provides DML and DDL. Each template supports four types of database (Oracle, MySql, Altibase and Tibero).
