

## Tabs

Tabs are enumerated horizontally to provide a navigation UI optimized to the mobile environment. Navbar (Tab) is used in Header and Footer areas. 1 to 5 tabs can be placed and icons can be displayed through option selection.

### Base Code

**data-role="navbar"** is used for navigation and **ui-btn-active** class value is used to show the activated tabs.

### eGovFrame

### navbar placement

You can use **<li>** tag to place 1 to 5 havbars. If one **<li>** tag is used in the Navbar section, the 100% width of the browser is used.

### eGovFrame

If two **<li>** tags are used in the Navbar section, the browser is divided into half and half.

If three `<li>` tags are used in the Navbar section, the browser is divided into 3 one thirds.

## eGovFrame

If four `<li>` tags are used in the Navbar section, the browser is divided into 4 one fourths.

## eGovFrame

    <li><a href="#">Three</a></li>
    <li><a href="#">Four</a></li>

If five `<li>` tags are used in the Navbar section, the browser is divided into 5 one fifths.

If more than 5 `<li>` tags are used in the Navbar section, one line will have two columns

## Shape Change (rounded tab)

By adding `class="egov-btn-corner-tl"` to the anchor tag in the Navbar, you can to create a left-rounded tab. By adding `class="egov-btn-corner-tr"`, you can create a right-rounded tab.

## Navigation between Documents

By setting **class="ui-btn-active"** , you can navigate between documents.

      <li><a href="#" class="ui-btn-active">One</a></li>
      <li><a href="#">Two</a></li>

    </ul>
  </div>

## Navigation between Documents

By setting **data-role="tabs"** , you can navigate between documents.

      <li><a href="#tab-3" >Tab 3</a></li>
    </ul>
  </div>
</div>
<div data-role="content">
  <div id="tab-1">
    <h1><font color="red">Here is the first tab</font></h1><br/><br/>
  </div>

<div id="tab-2">
  <h1><font color="blue">Here is the second tab</font></h1><br/><br/>
</div>
<div id="tab-3">
  <h1><font color="green">Here is the third tab</font></h1><br/><br/>
</div>
</div>
```

Use **data-icon="icon"** to add icons to the tabs
